Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

Readings: Ex 34: 4-6, 8-9; 2 Cor 13: 11-13; Jn 3: 16-18



Today, on the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, St. Paul reflects on the limits of our experience of God in this life. As we grow from childhood to adulthood, our knowledge of God remains incomplete until we come into God's presence and are welcomed into his Kingdom.

The Father and the Son's exchange of love is so perfect that everything they have is entirely given to the other, without reservation or expectation of anything in return. This eternal giving and receiving of love is the foundation of the divine communion between them, and it is from this love that the Holy Spirit, the expression of their shared perfect love, proceeds. We have received the gift of the Holy Spirit in baptism and, through our faith in the mysteries and traditions handed down to us over the centuries, we regularly sign ourselves in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit not only as we pray but in the face of many of life's challenges and experiences.

Let us give thanks for the unfailing, lavish and unconditional love of our God for each one of us. May we appreciate the magnificence of God's gifts, like the three young men did in the face of torment in "the fiery furnace". We, like the Israelites, can be "an obstinate people". Let us allow God's Triune love to overflow into our lives.

Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, You are a perfect communion of divine Love. Your love is so great, so perfect, so strong, that you have drawn us into Your very Life, making each of us a gift of your Love to others. We thank you for this unfathomable gift and ask the Holy Spirit to dwell within us so that your mutual self-giving may be manifested in our lives.
